

# REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS RELOCATION OF HOUSE LOCATED AT 11 MARKET STREET

The State of Maine Judicial Branch (MJB) has purchased an existing house located at 11 Market Street in Belfast, Maine. The house must be removed to allow construction of a new Court facility. The State MJB, with the assistance of the City of Belfast, is seeking proposals from parties who are interested in owning the existing house and who are willing to relocate it by the date of August 15, 2017 and in accordance with terms identified in the Request for Proposal.
