

CITY OF BELFAST ELECTION NOTICE

On July 14, 2020 the polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. for the State of Maine Primary Election and the State of Maine Referendum Election at the following locations:

Wards 1, 2, 3 & 4: The Crosby Center 96 Church Street

Wards 5: Belfast United Methodist Church 23 Mill Lane

Sample Ballots are available on our website, cityofbelfast.org and in the Clerk's Office for viewing.

Absentee Ballots are available at the Belfast City Clerk's Office.

Applications are available online (www.cityofbelfast.org), or in person at the City Clerk's Office. You can also come into City Hall and vote in the presents of the Clerk up until July 13, 2020.

There are 4 ways to request an absentee ballot:

- 1) In-person at the City Clerk's Office during the hours of the City Clerk: Mon – Fri 8:30 am to 4:00 pm. We are also open for extended hours on Thursday July 9th until 7:00pm. Residents of Belfast may also register to vote during these hours or make changes to current voting information such as a change of name, address or party affiliation. Address changes should be made by July 13th in order for your name to be printed on the correct Ward Voter List. We will have a Registrar available at each polling location on Election Day as well.
- 2) By Phone/Mail - call the City Clerk at 338-3370 Ext 114. The Clerk must speak directly with the Voter requesting the ballot.
- 3) Immediate Family Member – must fill out an application at the Clerk's Office.
- 4) 3rd Person – application required. Call the City Clerk at 338-3370 Ext 114 for information or stop by the City Clerk's Office. Ballots cast using this method must be witnessed by either the City Clerk, Notary Public, or Clerk of Courts, or by two other witnesses.
